### **CREW LEADER**

- Responsible for overall success of the expedition and safety, comfort and participation of each individual.
- Sees that crew operates efficiently and strictly within the rules and regulations of Philmont and B.S.A.
- Communicates and coordinates with adult advisors.
- Develops rotating duty roster and supervises its operation.
- Directly supervises Chefs, Firechief and Navigator.
- Becomes thoroughly familiar with itinerary and carries a Philmont map.
- Responsible for "Leave No Trace" camping

### **ASSISTANT CREW LEADER**

- Responsible for all duties of Crew Leader as necessary.
- Supervises Chaplain, Chronicler and Medic.
- Supervises service project
- Serves as Quartermaster and keeps up with location of crew gear.
- Distributes crew gear and food packets daily.
- Responsible for setting up dining fly and tent locations
- Responsible for Bear Bag and contents.

### **NAVIGATOR**

- Responsible for correct location and trail choices.
- Carries Philmont map and Compass
- Becomes thoroughly familiar with itinerary and regularly confers with Crew Leader on distances, schedule and location.
- Takes sightings and map checks at each trail crossing.
- Monitors crew location at all times.

### **CHEF**

- Responsible for efficient, timely and attractive preparation and serving meals.
- Assures proper amount of water for cooking.
- Reads food preparation instructions fully before opening food packets
- Maintains a safe and sanitary cook area.
- Puts wash water on stove before eating.

## **FIRECHIEF**

- Responsible for fuel supply and stoves.
- Lights all stoves
- Refuels stoves after each use.
- Monitors stoves during cooking and turns off when not needed.

## **MEDIC**

- Responsible for health and welfare of all crew members.
- In charge of and carries First Aid Kit.
- Administers First Aid when necessary.
- Supervises water purification.
- Inspects cooking gear for cleanliness.
- Monitors crew for sunburn, dehydration, hypothermia, foot problems, heat exhaustion/stroke.

## **CHAPLAIN**

- Responsible for carrying the devotional book.
- Conducts daily devotional.
- Leads crew in prayers before meals.
- Checks on attitude and outlook of each crew member daily and coordinates with Medic concerning health and welfare of each crew member.

## **CHRONICLER**

- Responsible for crew journal.
- Keeps a daily record of trek (altitude, trails, weather, wildlife, flora, fauna, sites, camps, events, activities and participation.)
- Sees that postcards are mailed by each crew member.
- Distributes mail.

## **ROTATING DUTIES**

Chef does not perform any of these duties.

WT – Water

KP – Washes crew cooking gear and carries garbage bag.

DF – Dining Fly

BB – Bear Bag
