TIME SCHEDULE:

0800 Depart to Kill Kare Landing

Sun. 3 August

0700 Rise and air bedding
0730 Breakfast and cleanup
1400 Meet outfitter & shuttle @ Good Hope Landing
1930 Arrive back at Mt. View Church

LOGISTICAL NOTES:

We will firm up departure times and transportation during July.
We will operate in 4-6 man cook teams. Each team will be responsible for their meals, equipment and clean-up. Each team will travel together on the river.
All persons will wear a PFD will on the river – no exceptions. If you have a personal PFD you may bring it, or you can use one from the outfitter.

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT

Pack your gear as if you were backpacking – lightweight. Do not bring anything extra with you. Make sure everything is waterproofed. If your canoe should tip over, it's all going in the river.

- Wear - Swim trunks, T-shirt, hat and canoe shoes (sandals or water shoes NO FLIP_FLOPS or CROCS)
- Internal frame pack or duffel bag
- Camp clothes, closed-toe camp shoes and jacket
- Towel
- Rain gear
- Toilet kit w/paper
- Personal mess kit
- 2 Water bottles or hydration system
- Compass, matches, flashlight and other ten essentials
- Sleeping Bag & Pad
- Tent or tarp (you will need mosquito netting in order to sleep.)
- Sunscreen & Insect repellent
- Camp chair

Patrol equipment must be carried in the canoes.

- Stove
- Cook pots and utensils
- Water (min. 1 gal. per person)
- Food
- First Aid Kit
- Bear Bag & Rope
- Water purification

YOU MUST BE ABLE TO CARRY YOUR GEAR FROM THE RIVER TO THE CAMPSITE. THE DISTANCES WILL BE BETWEEN .25 AND .5 MILES ON NIGHTS 2 & 3.
